A lifelong resident of Jackson County, Ms Johnston was born March 27, 1926 to the late Sanford and Annie Brown.

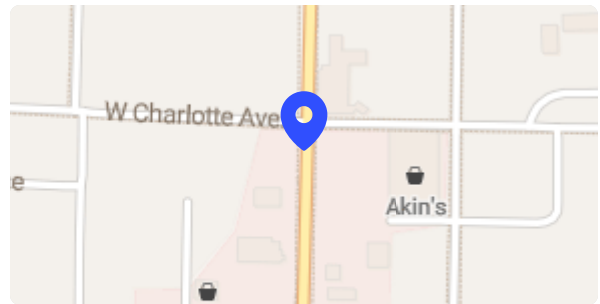
