Isaiah Hill, Jr. 70 of Bridgeport, Alabama, died February 11, 2018 at his home. Isaiah was born March 29, 1947 in Bridgeport, Alabama to the late Isaiah Hill, Sr. and Frances Allison of Bridgeport, Alabama. He is survived by his wife Sandra Mae Blair Hill of Bridgeport; daughter Salene Hill and granddaughter Ashley Hill of Indianapolis, Indiana; brother Fred L. Hill of Cleveland, Tennessee. 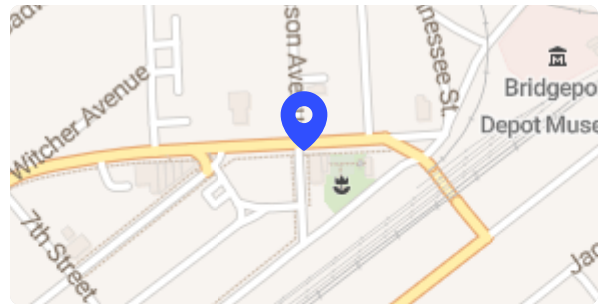

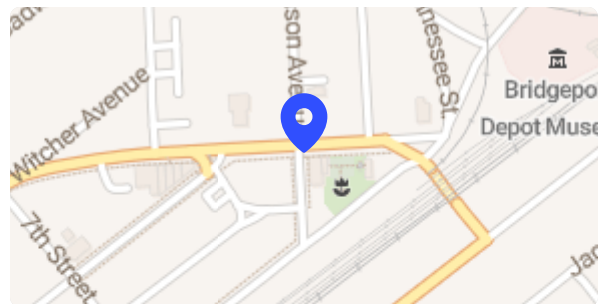
