# Mr. Kenneth "Coach" McKinney

JAN 8, 1935 - MAR 3, 2021

**C**oach Kenneth Harold McKinney, age 86 of Vernon, AL, passed away Wednesday, March 3, 2021, at his residence surrounded by his family.

Coach McKinney was born January 8, 1935, in Tuscumbia, AL. He was a football coach and won three state championships. He was also a faithful member of the Vernon First United Methodist Church. In addition to coaching football, Coach McKinney also enjoyed spending time with his family. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his foster parents, Talmage and Vera Bumpus; his son, Kenny McKinney; his daughter, Kathy McKinney; and his foster brothers and sisters.

Funeral services will be Saturday, at 2:00 PM, at the Vernon First United Methodist Church with Patrick Gunn officiating. Burial will follow at Henry Cemetery in Corinth, MS. Visitation will be at the church, 12:00-2:00, prior to the service.

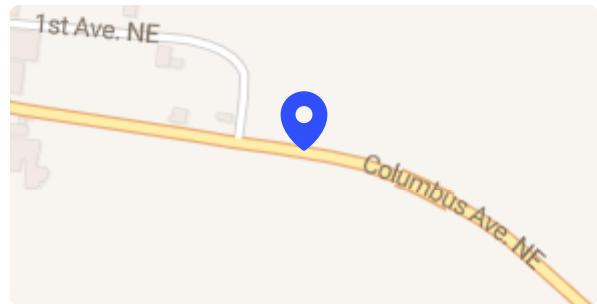

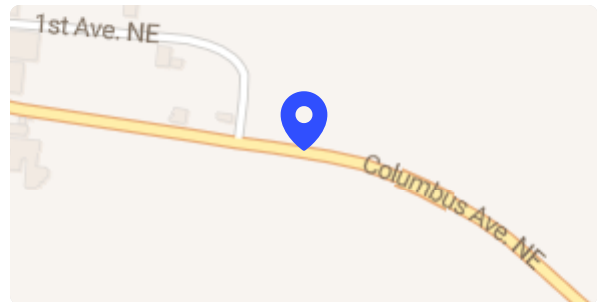
